

The “No Outsiders” Project in Tower Hamlets

We have kept the level of support we can offer to school very flexible and devised two different levels.

Level 1

INSET delivered by Mark Jennett for all staff which, depending on time available and the school’s requirements, would include input around:

- legislation, guidance and support
- raising awareness of the extent and impact of homophobia and gender stereotyping in primary schools
- adult concerns about discussing same sex relationships
- dealing with homophobic language
- target-setting, policy development
- looking at available resources (especially the books) but also including LGBT History Month, other teaching resources

Level 2

All the above plus:

- input to the curriculum
- Chinwag workshops for children
- a complete set of books chosen to support teachers in raising gender equality awareness.

Accessing funding

- Up to £5,000 is available per school.
- Mark Jennett and Chinwag will be paid directly by the Equalities Team, Children, Schools and Families, on completion of their work.
- Schools will be reimbursed for No Outsiders books ordered, if a copy of a paid invoice is submitted.
